2013 Report

Serious floods affected **Aceh**. The school had to close for a few weeks during this natural disaster and for a further week post-flooding to allow for a clean up. This affected the school syllabus as the children missed one-month worth of studies.



With this in mind, we prioritized the refurbishment of the school and made sure it was carried out as quickly and effectively as possible. After three months of works, we rebuilt the seriously damaged front of the building as half the wall had been destroyed. The flooding affected the majority of Aceh and all schools on the island were falling behind with

regards to the national curriculum. Our focus now is to catch up on the time that was lost and motivate the children with their learning because many suffered not only a disruption with their schooling but also in their personal lives as many homes were damaged.

In **Serpong**, the external walls of the school are now complete. We are pleased to announce that the exam results for 2013 were excellent. The staff and students are on good form and we have received nothing but positive feedback. Parents are very proud to send their children to this school due to the strong reputation that we have developed. Thank you for making this possible!

Myself, Helen and Oliver Hatch-Barnwell visited several projects this summer. We carried out some checks and internal auditing. We also spent time in the schools volunteering, teaching and informing the students of the charity's history, explaining how we started and all the amazing developments we have been able to carry out thanks to your donations!



In **Bali**, it is difficult to keep some of the children in school as many parents move from island to island out of fear of being deported. We encourage the

parents to keep their children in school where possible. For those that stay, we see a huge improvement and we will continue to try our best to help.

We are pleased with the organization in **Padang**, with your help we were able to assist many victims of the eruption of Gunung Rejo (the volcano). We would like to raise more funds in order to help the affected children with their education.
