In **Serpong** we completed further refurbishment works as the front wall was deteriorating and the front gate fell apart.

We have had issues finding a handyman due to new property developments in the area creating many manual labor jobs that are chosen over our vacancy but we will persevere in our recruitment process and remain positive.

Our headmistress has continued to carry out an excellent job. We are pleased to announce that from the money provided from the fee-paying students, the teachers have been able to receive an increased salary.

We would like to further utilize the school in **Aceh**. We plan to work alongside a local charity that helps orphans to use the school in the afternoon as the current children only use the building for the morning classes (as per standard nursery school hours in Indonesia).



The project would consist in providing activities for the orphans in the afternoon and build dormitories to provide a home for them. In order to carry out this project, the first step will be to finish the walls that surround the school for security and then start work on building further loos and bathrooms. A big thank you all for the money raised as this has enabled us to complete phase one of the project!

Our head of the street children program in **Bali** is still working very hard. Two of the children have left the school unexpectedly (half way through the school year) as their parents were deported. Nevertheless, after a lot of hard work and administration, we managed to fulfill the difficult task of finding two new children to replace the other students.

In **Padang**, we were approached by a school called Brilliant in order for us to help them with funding. After the usual background checks and thanks to your generous donations, we are very pleased that we were able to assist in paying the teachers salaries. As a result we have many happy children who can continue their schooling as the school would have had to close down without your help!
