2015 Report

All projects experienced difficulty this year due to harsh weather conditions.

In **Serpong**, the wind destroyed a large part of the roof of the school. Luckily there were no injuries. However, lengthy works were carried out to fix the damage. As a result, this caused disruption to the classes and sadly this affected the final year exam results. Consequently, fewer new students enrolled in the school. The headmistress and the teachers are working hard to rebuild the academic standards in spite of the recent disruptions.



We plan to hand over our school in Aceh to Hidayatullah (a recognized nonprofit origination in Indonesia) who will run the school moving forward. The building will still be owned by the Hatch-Barnwell Charitable Trust but Hidayatullah will take over completely on the management front. Building works

had begun in order for the school to be in the best possible condition prior to the handover. We are pleased to announce that the building of the wall surrounding the school was successfully completed ensuring security for all students. Nevertheless, due to strong winds one of the buildings collapsed. Unfortunately, the headmistress of the school faced many issues with the builders who did not carry out the work properly and after several months of trying to resolve the problem she was forced to look for new builders. We are relieved that the new builders are professional and hope to complete all works including the construction of new dormitories by May in order to have a smooth transition and to further utilize the school.

We are still experiencing the same problems with the street children in **Bali**. It is a very difficult task to keep the children in school and encourage them not to drop out. However, their parents' fear of being deported often goes against us being able to help them. We will continue to encourage and support these children and their parents to the best of our capabilities.



In **Padang**, our earthquake victim project is very successful. Thanks to your generous donations, we are now able to help 70 children with their education which has also greatly helped each individual return to a more stable life after the devastating effects of the earthquake.

Our other project on the same island (the collaboration with Brilliant school) is also thriving. Without your donations the school would not have survived and be forced to close down due to lack of funds. On the grounds of its popularity, Brilliant have proposed to add further

classes in order to help more children. We have agreed to the proposal and will begin extending the school shortly.

We are pleased to announce that we have a new project in **Gunung Kidul** to fund the complete schooling of 5 children at the Ansharullah boarding school. This is a particular poor area and with your donation these children are ensured an education that they would not be able to have without your help.
