

2016 Report

We are pleased to announce that 2016 was a more productive year than 2015, due firstly, to an improvement in the weather conditions than the prior year. Secondly, the school had been refurbished previously, allowing valuable time to be spent educating the children, which is our ultimate objective.

Serpong

In Serpong, we desperately need to build a Secondary School, close to the Primary School that we built previously. In order to achieve this we have been saving and raising more funds by the way of donations, in order to buy the land required where the school would be situated. We would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every generous person who has contributed through a donation, which has allowed us to buy the land on which the Secondary School will be built.

Aceh

In Aceh, we handed over the nursery school that we built specifically to educate the many children who were victims of the tsunami in 2005, to Hidayatullah (a recognized non-profit organization in Indonesia). We believe that the teachers at the school and the Hidayatullah are continuing to work hard together, to maintain the high standard achieved at the school.

Bali

In 2016, the government in Bali announced that anyone not possessing Balinese residency would no longer be allowed to remain in the island and would have to return to their original island, or incur a financial penalty. This had a major impact on our project to aid the street children we were helping, as obviously parents returned to their own island and took their children with them, reducing the number we were working with considerably.

Padang

We continue to do well in our earthquake victim project in Padang since 2010 and are pleased to announce that we still have the capability to maintain the education for 70 children. Through our support, we ensure that the children are able to continue with their schooling in their early developmental years. If it was at all possible to increase this number, we would be delighted to do so, however, we are also fundraising for our 2nd project in Padang.

Our second project, in collaboration with 'Brilliant School' has not progressed as much as we would have liked unfortunately, due to the lack of funds. It is our intention to continue the fundraising campaign in order to extend the school, our goal being that we can cater for more children.

Gunung Kidul

We currently fully support the education of 5 children at the Ansharullah Boarding School, however the school itself is very run-down and in need of urgent refurbishment, possibly even a rebuild. We are fully committed to this cause and are looking to address this situation in the coming year.
