2017 Report

2017 came with new challenges for The Hatch-Barnwell Charitable Trust, which I am delighted to say that we managed not only to overcome through sheer perseverance, and determination, but ended the year successfully building our new school in Gunung Kidul. The initial plan was to build the Secondary School in Serpong on the land that we had previously bought in 2016. However due to the lengthy processes in obtaining the building planning license, we were not able to go ahead with this project in 2017. However, this then allowed us to spend the time and effort required to proceed with building the new school in Gunung Kidul, as we were concerned with the safety of the children, due to the derelict building as mentioned in last year's annual report. Once the new school had been built towards the end of the year, The Hatch-Barnwell Charitable Trust donated the building to the Yayasan - Ansharullah Boarding School as a gift.

Gunung Kidul

It was always our intention to address the run-down infrastructure at the school in Gunung Kidul, as it needed urgent refurbishment. We are delighted to announce that we made a start on this project in January 2017, and by June, we had accomplished this. We were initially concerned that the works may not be completed by the start of the school year in July, however though the hard work and excellent project management skills provided by Ibu Titik Purwo, we finished in good time. The Hatch-Barnwell Charitable Trust would like to take this opportunity to thank all of our generous customers in Kebab Kid, without whose donations this valuable charity work would not be possible. Serpong

The Primary School in Serpong 'Yayasan Bina Cendekia Indonesia' is achieving satisfactory results as expected. However the parents whose children have finished Primary School face difficulty finding a Secondary School, which is affordable to them. From the charities perspective, as soon as we obtain the license to build the Secondary School, we will start work on building it on the land we previously bought and hope that we can progress with this soon.

Aceh

The nursery school that was handed over to Hidayatullah in 2016, still produces good academic results, which then allows the children to progress to a good Primary School. However The Hatch-Barnwell Charitable Trust would like to see an improvement in the general maintenance of the schools grounds, to provide a better environment and improved safety for the children who attend the school.

Bali

Bali continues to prove challenging to the Trust, due to the diminishing numbers of children. It has become apparent that people arriving from Java, are unable to find employment in Bali, and although this increases the number of children on the street, many are reluctant to be educated. The trustees therefore feel that we need to review the situation going forwards in 2018.

Padang

Even though we are currently schooling 70 children in both Primary and Secondary education, The Hatch-Barnwell Charitable Trust intend to try and increase this number in the future, to cater for the many children in the villages and mountains in the surrounding areas with volcanic activity.

The second project in Padang in collaboration with 'Brilliant School' still continues to be our focus, however we need to prioritise other more urgent projects first. We hope to dedicate more time on this project going forwards.
